RULES OF APPLICATION

Letters Which May Be Romanized in Different Ways Depending on Their Context

1. °, ^, ^ (*jazm*) indicates the absence of any vowel following the letter over which it is written. It is not represented in romanization.

2. When (shaddah) appears over any consonant or digraph, represent it in romanization by doubling the consonant or digraph.

3. Romanize ئ (alif maqṣūrah) used in place of I' to represent the long vowel as á.



4. When the word ending in \ddot{a} is in the construct state, romanize \ddot{a} as t.

Tarjamat al-si<u>rr</u>u al-jalīl Sūrat al-Fātiḥah تَرْجَمَة الْسِّرُّ الْجَليلُ سُورَة الْقارِنِحة

5. When medial or final, romanize c (hamzah) as '.

خُلَفاَء Khulafā'

6. Romanize the Arabic article $\mathring{\mathbb{U}}$ (also written $\mathring{\mathbb{U}}$) as *al*-.
